

Free Trash Day Tokens for Gilpin County residents.

Each residential property in Gilpin County is eligible for one free trash day token per calendar year. Tokens are intended to assist with an annual clean up, and are valid for up to 5 cubic yards of waste. **2023 Token is valid until December 17, 2023.**

- Residents must receive the token from the Public Works Office prior to bringing any loads.
- To request a token, send an email with your name and property address to gcpw@gilpincounty.org. We can usually have the token ready for you to pick up the next business day.
- Residents are required to show proof of residency or property ownership to pick up their token. and must be present with Free Trash Day loads.
- Tokens for rental houses may be picked up by the landlord with proof of ownership OR by the tenant with proof of residency.
- Owners of undeveloped residential land may receive only one token to clean up their multiple lots.
- Tokens are not transferrable or replaceable.
- Tokens are:
 - Valid one day only of the resident's choosing during the calendar year they are issued. 2023 tokens are green in color, and must be used by December 17th, 2023;
 - Limited to 5 cubic yards. Can be multiple trips on the same day. Debris rates of \$30 per yard will be charged on portions exceeding 5 yards. Please note: Loads are measured by volume, so pack your load accordingly;
 - Valid for general clean ups, including construction debris, old furniture, and most appliances.
 - Yard waste must be bagged;
 - For residential clean up, not commercial properties;
 - Not transferrable and are to be used to clean up the property the token is assigned to.
- Items that are **not included** in Free Trash Day, and are not free with tokens include:
 - Household garbage;
 - **Tires, Mattresses;**
 - TV's, computers & other **electronic waste**;
 - Car batteries, motor oil & antifreeze.The above items can be disposed of at the transfer site for a fee.
 - Refrigerators, freezers are not accepted at the transfer station. See list of disposal options on our website.
 - Bricks, Concrete, asphalt, dirt and stumps are not accepted at the transfer station.

Please leave the token attached to the paper form, this will help speed up the process at the transfer station.
