PROCLAMATION ELDER ABUSE PREVENTION AWARENESS DAY

WHEREAS, elder abuse is the broad term used to identify mistreatment of elderly and disabled adults; and

WHEREAS, abuse and neglect of elderly and disabled adults is one of the most under-recognized and under-reported social problems in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the magnitude of the problem is likely to increase for several reasons, especially with the increase in the elderly population; and

WHEREAS, mistreatment can take many forms: physical abuse, emotional abuse, sexual abuse, neglect by a caregiver, self-neglect, exploitation, and financial exploitation; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that approximately five million people age 60+ suffer elder abuse every year; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that approximately only one out of every twenty-four cases of elder abuse is reported; and

WHEREAS, abuse of the elderly and disabled is preventable;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED by the Gilpin County Board of Commissioners that June 15, 2022 be recognized as "Elder Abuse Prevention Awareness Day" in Gilpin County and that all residents and other jurisdictions are encouraged to become more aware of this problem and join in the prevention of elder abuse.
