

# Is Your Home Safe From Radon? Winter Is The Best Time To Test!








In Colorado, living in a home with average levels of radon (6.4pCi/L) for one year is like having 200 chest x-rays every vear. That's more than three chest x-rays for every person in the house every week.

### Radon causes cancer

Every year in the U.S., over people die from lung cancer caused by radon.



Radon decays into radioactive particles that, when inhaled, can damage the DNA in sensitive lung cells. The damaged cells can become cancerous.

of homes in Colorado have high radon levels




Ask your home inspector about radon and request a radon test.
