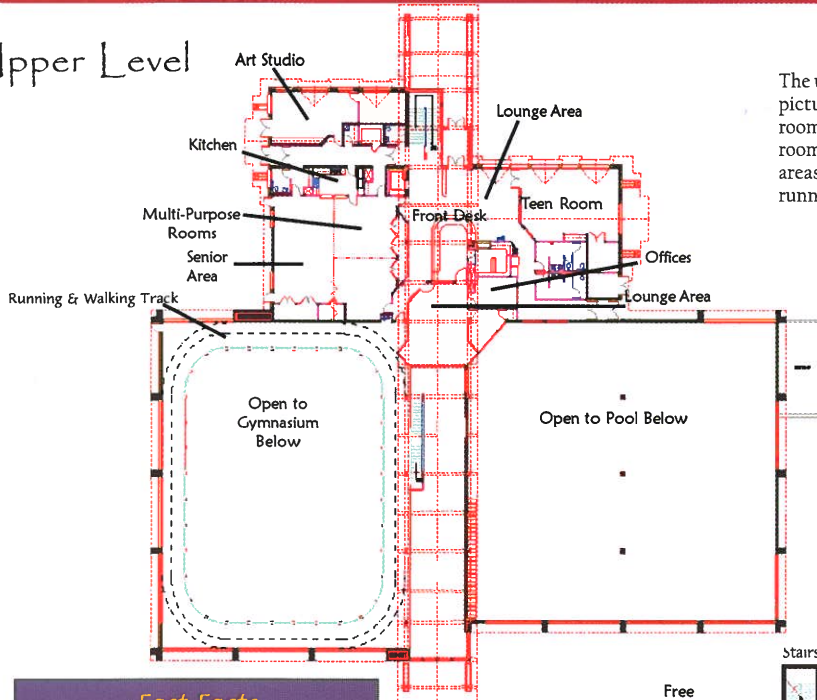

Upper Level



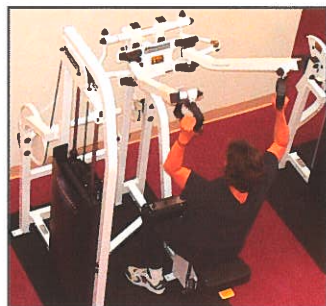
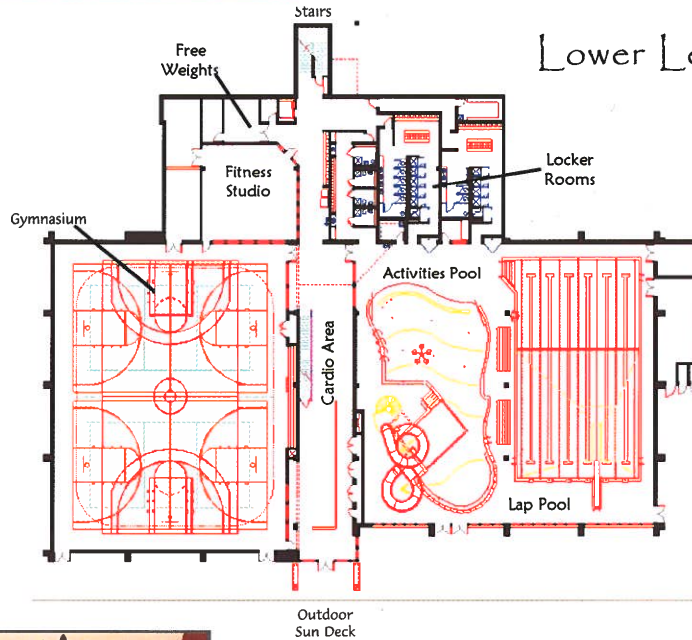
The upper level of the community center, pictured left, includes an art studio/wet crafts room, senior area, teen room, multi-purpose rooms, kitchen, reception area, two lounge areas for the public, staff offices, and the running/walking track which is 1/16 of a mile.

The lower level of the community center, pictured below, contains the gymnasium, fitness studio, free weights area, cardio area, activities pool with water slide and other play features, lap pool with diving board, and locker rooms. The south end of the cardio area frames the surrounding landscape with a full wall of windows, allowing natural light to filter into the area.
