



Gilpin County Colorado REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS **Multiple Locations – Laborers for Removal of Trash on Properties**

Overview

Gilpin County, Colorado is requesting proposals from qualified contracting firms or individuals to provide general clean-up of properties in Gilpin County, specifically removing trash, rubbish, junk, scrap metal, weeds, etc... This may include heavy and/or irregularly shaped items requiring two or more individuals to move. This work would also occur on properties that are in violation of Gilpin County regulations and ordinances due to the accumulation of trash and under a court order allowing for the clean-up and removal.

Requirements for Work:

Ability to reliably provide removal and/or disposal services of trash, rubbish, scrap metal, weeds, etc..... This may require moving dirty, heavy and irregularly shaped materials or objects. The work would require in some instances documenting the trash items removed with photographs and itemized list of removed items.

Information and Qualifications Requested from Applicants:

- Hourly rates
- Business Name, contact name, telephone number, email, and fax number.
Description/list of services
- Proof of insurance and copy of general liability insurance, workers compensation, and automobile insurance including an covering the work to be done.
- Any information you would like the County to provide in regard to this work
- Existing requirements they have for their workers or work
- Whether they will remove the collected trash from the property and legally dispose of it
- Whether they can provide a roll-off container for trash disposal.
- If disposal services or roll-off container services are provided, please provide at what cost.
- An itemized list of costs will need to be included in all proposals including labor rates and any expected material costs.
- Qualifications for this work and experience
- Number of available employees - laborers
- If hauling or disposing of trash, proper licensing for that.
- Proof of current professional applicable licenses in good standing for work requiring licensure.
- Any references you believe are relevant
- Gilpin County reserves the right to request any additional information it decides would be helpful in evaluating proposals.
- Responders may provide additional information they may feel is helpful for consideration by the County.

Deadline for Submittals. There is no deadline for submittals. Gilpin County hopes to develop a list of qualified businesses and individuals to perform the work requested. We do, however, hope to receive responses to this as soon as possible as the County has trash removal projects it would like to complete this month.
