- Familiarity with this specific cemetery.
- Current documentation of the cemetery.
- Should the cemetery be expanded and what affect that will have on the existing cemetery.
- What part of this is under the review and scope of history and HAC?
- To some studying buildings is preferential to cemeteries?

It was decided to conduct a field trip of the cemeteries, including Bald Mountain on Friday August 3, 2007 to gain an overall familiarity with them. HAC requested more work be performed on the initial proposal for the Bald Mountain Cemetery.
