- Residents with more than 4 boxes (or non-residents) can check back after 11:30 to see if there is extra room in the shredding truck.
- The Shred-A-Thon is free to Gilpin Residents; however, you are encouraged to bring non-perishable items or cash contributions for our Gilpin County Food Pantry.
