

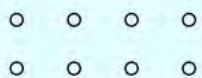

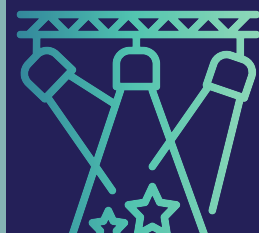
**COMMUNITY CENTER & POOLS

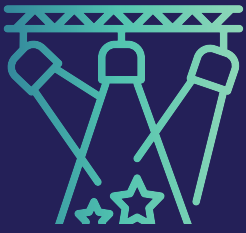

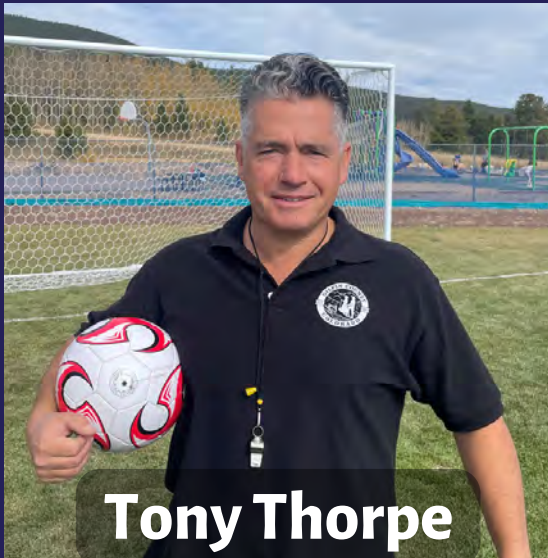




Staff Spotlight

Volunteer Soccer Coaches

Tony Thorpe

"I'm a local real estate professional. I've been coaching soccer for 13 years now. This is my 10th year coaching in Gilpin. I grew up in England and played lots of sports. I captained my high school team to win the national championship in 1989. In 1991 I came over to the US to play on the UCF golf team. I had golf scholarship, then a soccer scholarship and later played on the rugby team too. I've lived in Florida, Georgia, South Carolina, North Carolina, California, Pennsylvania and Massachusetts mostly working in casinos. I moved to Colorado in 2012 and I love it here.

For recreation I play indoor soccer in Arvada, I still play golf and also go to the gym at the Gilpin Rec Center and ride bikes and ski with my kids. My Dad was a well-known rugby coach back in England and I saw what an important impact he made in the sport and for the community.

When he passed they filled the church and twice as many people were outside in the rain. More than one of the ex-players told me if it wasn't for my Dad mentoring them they would have been in jail. He got them off the streets and on to the rugby field.

I feel it's important for the local kids here to develop friendships, learn teamwork and have a sense of achievement. Soccer is also a great activity for cardio and physical health. I feel like they need as much opportunity as possible for physical activity. We have great kids here and I love coaching them. Cheers."

"I was raised playing soccer from a young age. Played through club, college, and through the ODP (Olympic development program) I played a year with the national team. Never got on the field for a game, but practiced and trained with them for a year. I have played pretty much every team sport you can think of. But Soccer was number one from the beginning.

I still play soccer every Friday night in Arvada indoor. I play a lot of frisbee golf and do a lot of hiking with the dogs and the family. But my main passion lately is downhill mountain biking. I've been racing professionally and coaching for about 10 years now.

Team sports builds trust and friendship and teamwork. I believe these are huge fundamentals for when the kids become adults and go into the real world. I feel kids that are playing team sports have a big step up on the world with these skills. It's important to me to share what I have learned through team sports because I really want to see the youth thrive."
