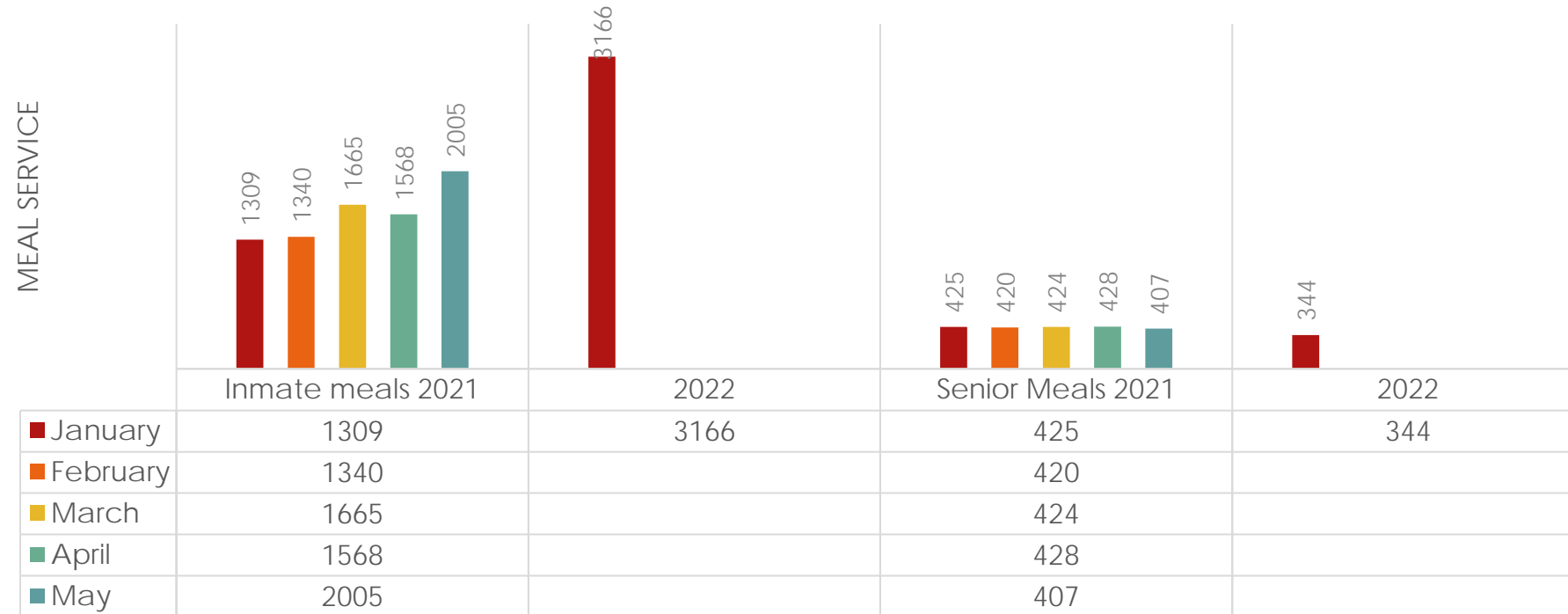

Detentions Arrests by Agency

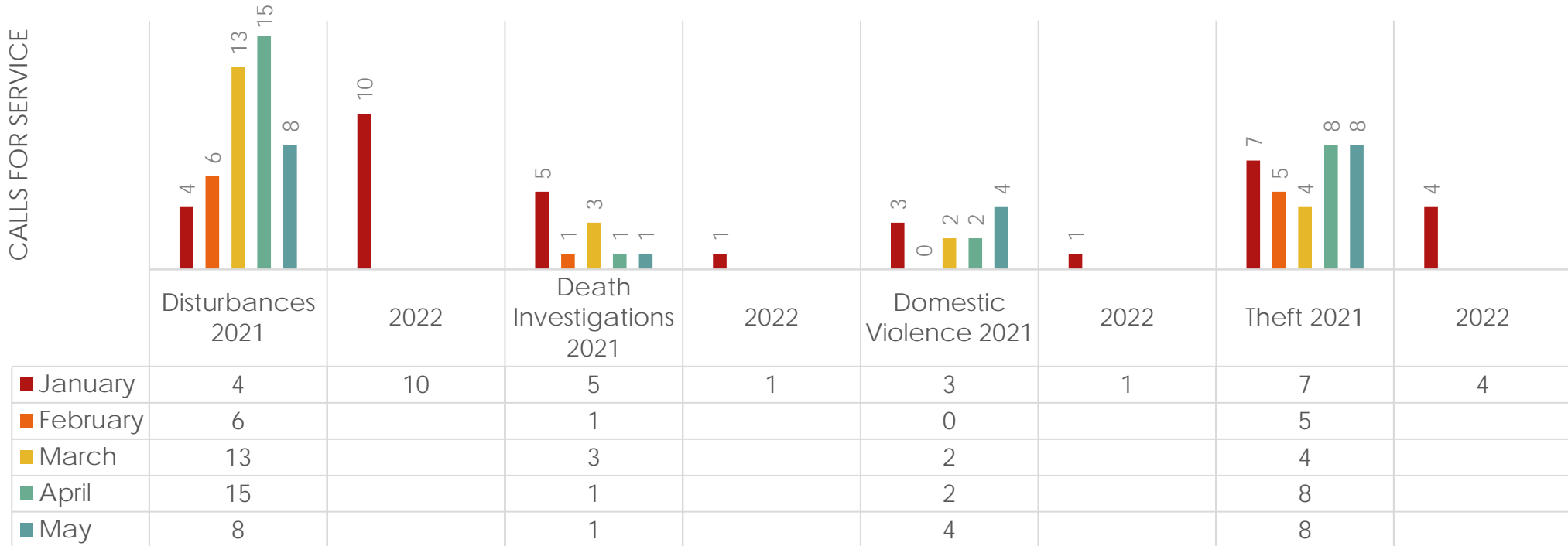
